AWARD CRITERIA**

Please address the ways in which the nominee fulfills the following criteria, with each response being a maximum of one page in length. Keep answers brief (point form is encouraged) and include quantifiable evidence when possible.

The President's Award will be presented to a **Canadian** whose personal activities and/or leadership and commitment to affairs of the public relations profession resulted in a striking demonstration of the profession's principles, the society's mission and/or code of professional standards, or personal activities and/or leadership that went beyond the call of duty or responsibility to an employer or client and made a pronounced contribution to the status and acceptance of the public relations function.

1) Professional Excellence/Advancement of the Public Relations Profession (40%)

- Demonstrated commitment to advancing the professional stature of public relations
- Demonstrated examples of practicing public relations according to the highest professional standards
- Demonstrated excellence in communications management
- Public profile

2) Contribution (30%)

- Demonstrated influence with key stakeholders, employees, clients and ability to build strong relationships
- Examples of commitment to two-way communication practices and relationship management

3) Short-Term or Specific Achievements (20%)

- Public impact
- Implementation of or advocacy for a major public relations initiative
- Leadership role
- Supportive attitude

4) Other Relevant Contributions (10%)

- *Mentoring, teaching, public speaking*
